The Gaza massacre which began when Israel bombed children on their way home from school on December 27, 2008 killed over 1300 people and injured over 5300 people. Around the world people witnessed the war crimes that Israel carried out in occupied Palestine - the collective punishment of the 1.5 million Palestinian people in Gaza; the targeting of civilians; the use of human shields; the use of white phosphorous in civilian areas; the bombing of schools and UN relief compounds. Most Western governments, including the Australian government are silent on these crimes. Israel continues to act with impunity in carrying out its genocidal policies in Palestine. Throughout the world, the grass-roots campaign to isolate Israel through the Boycott, Divestment, Sanctions movement is growing as ordinary people declare that they are not willing to be silent in the face of such atrocities. On April 2 there will be a protest in Brisbane against the Australia-Israel Chamber of Commerce - an organisation that promotes and lobbies for greater trade with Israel. The protest will highlight the government and corporate complicity with the war crimes carried out by Israel and call for the breaking of all ties with Israel. **No trade with war criminals.**
